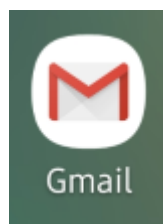


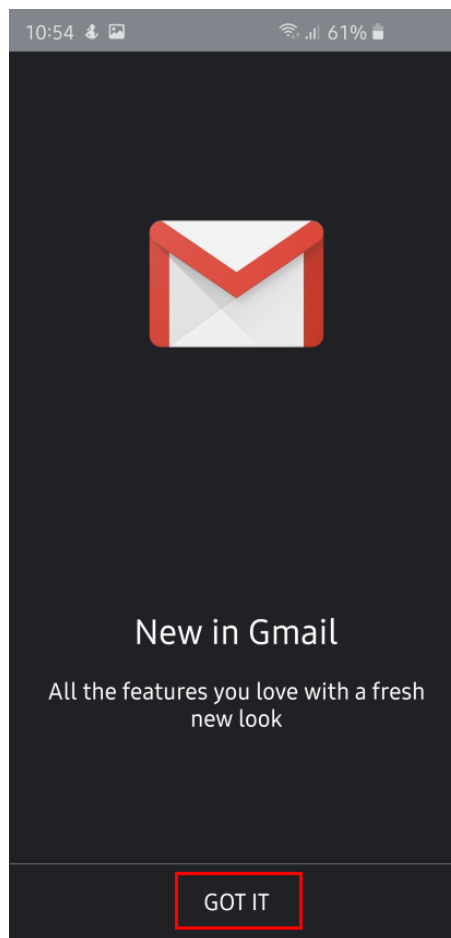

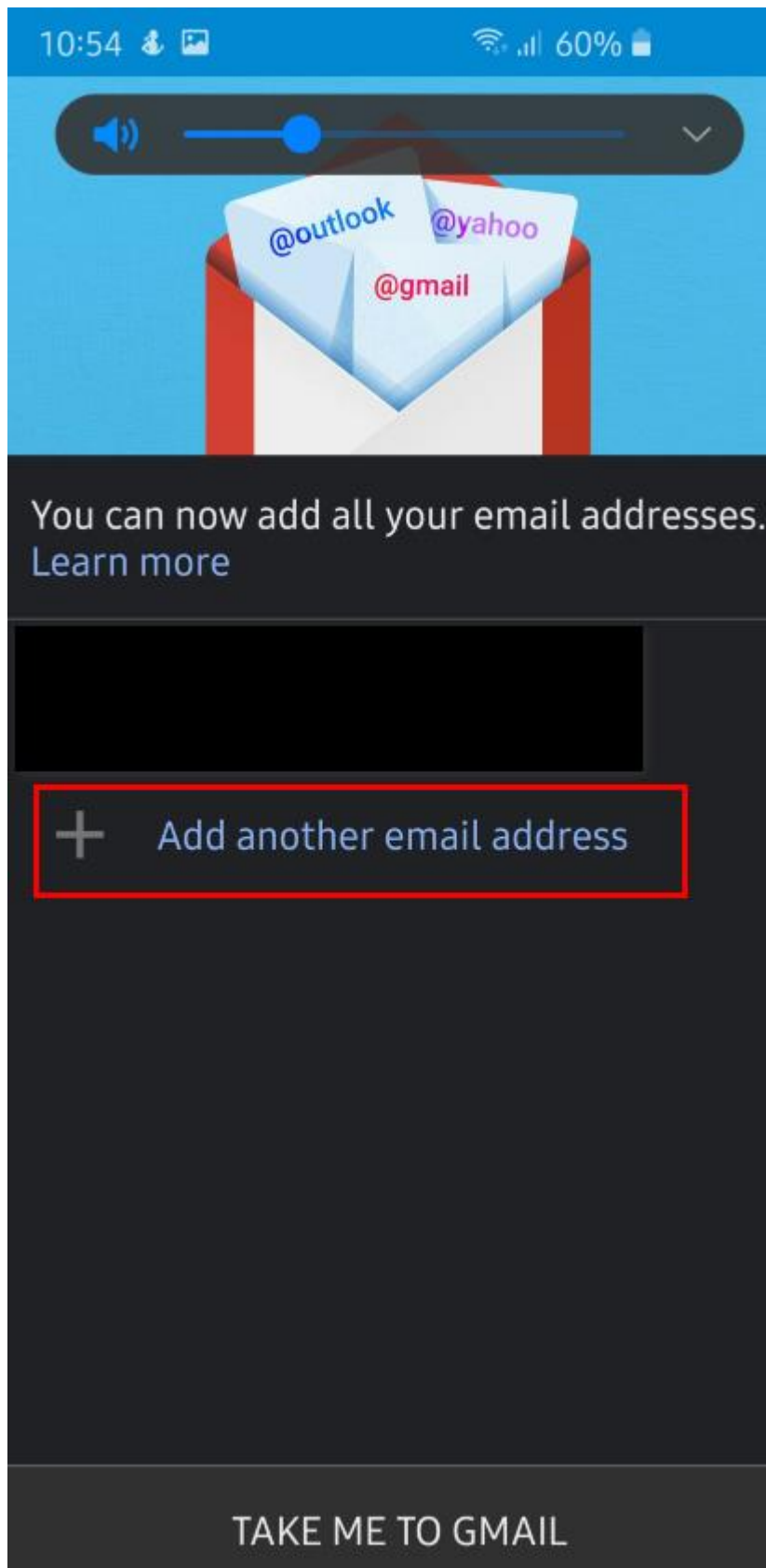
1. Tap on Gmail icon.



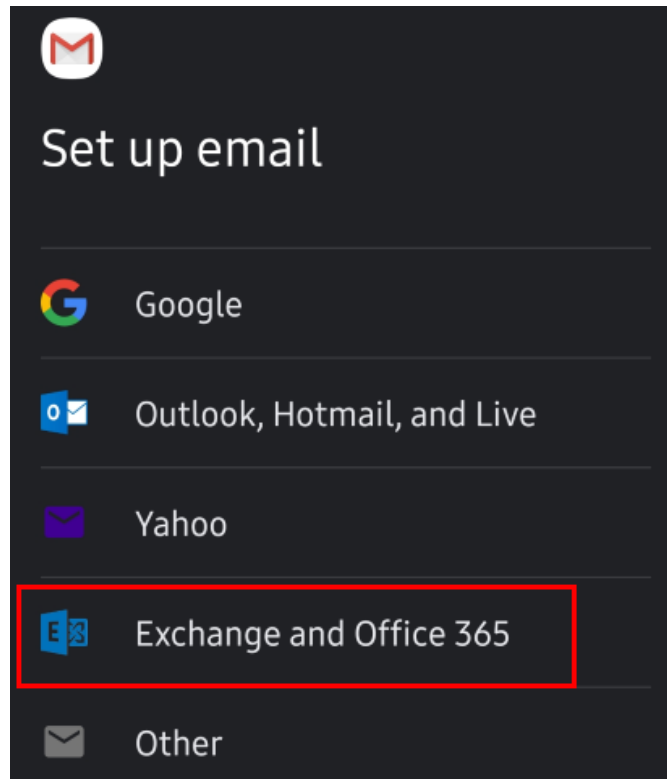
2. Tap on got it to go next page for setup.



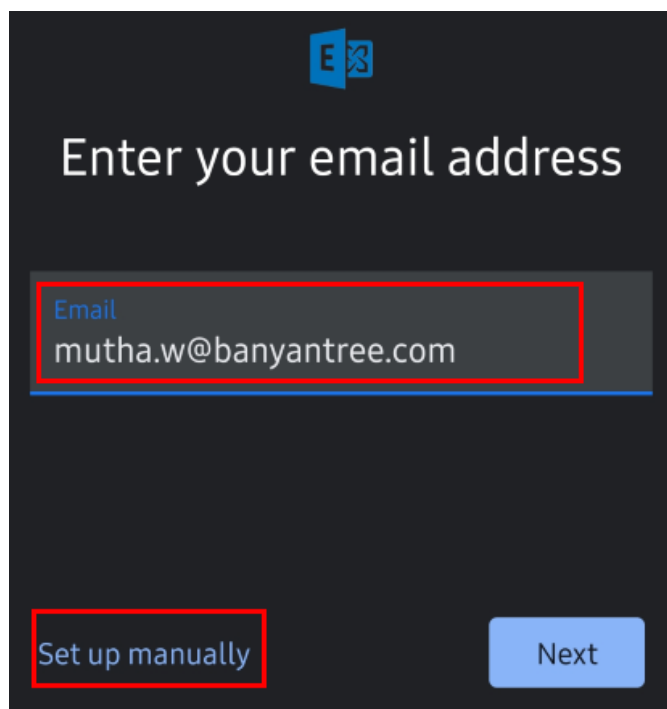
3. Tap on Add another email address.



4. Select Email type to Exchange.



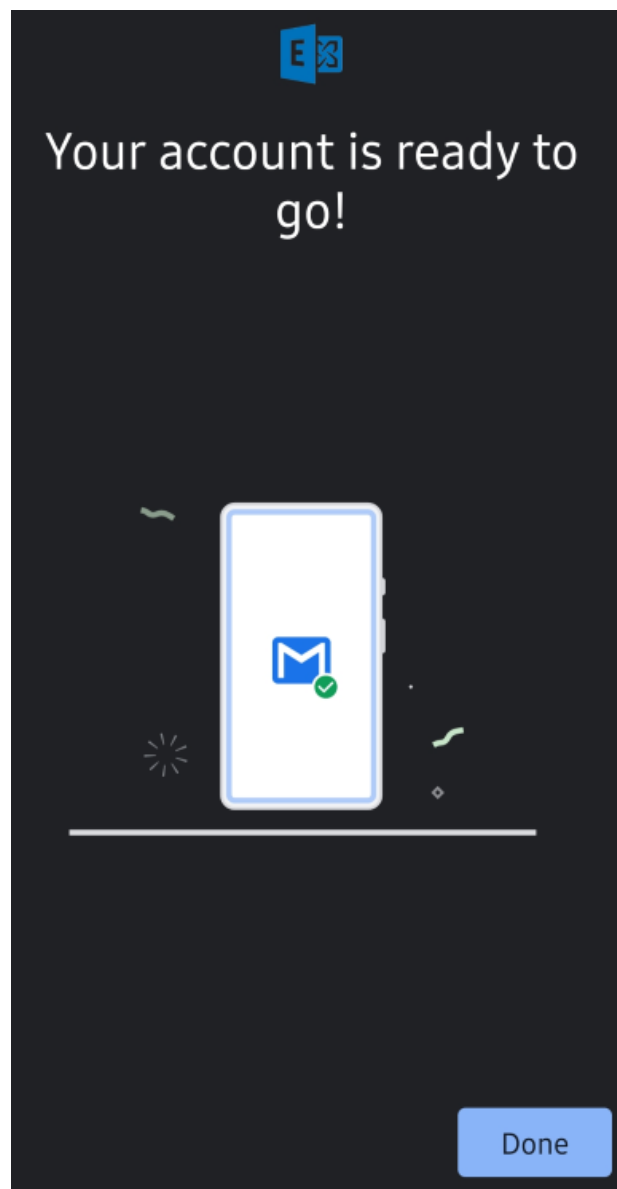
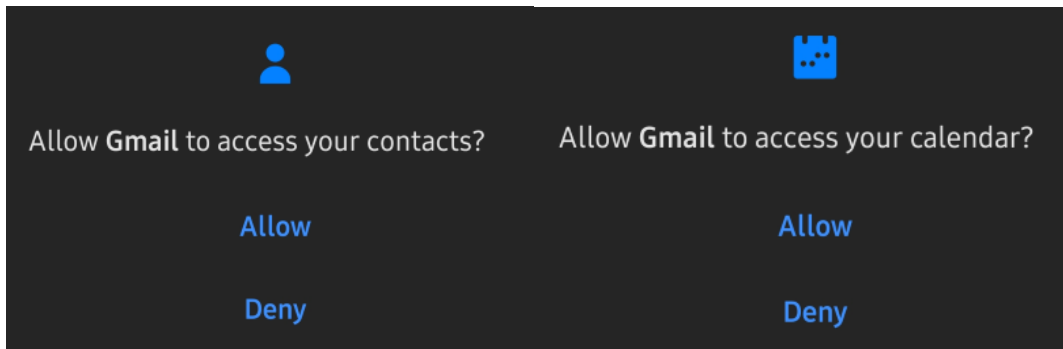
5. Enter your Email and tap on Set up manually.



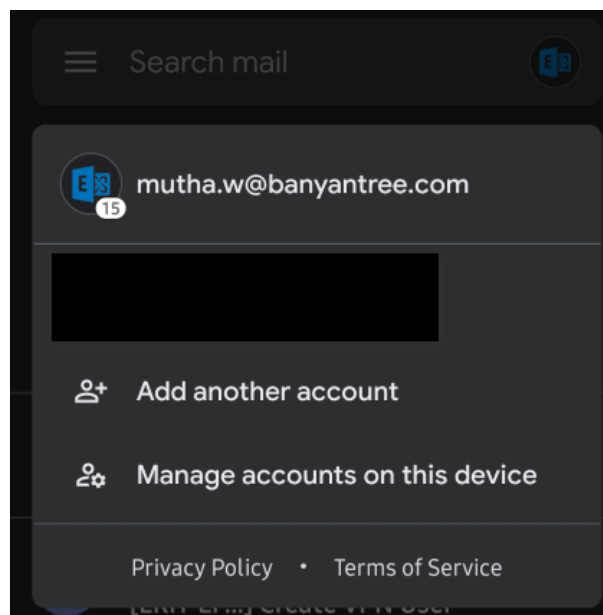
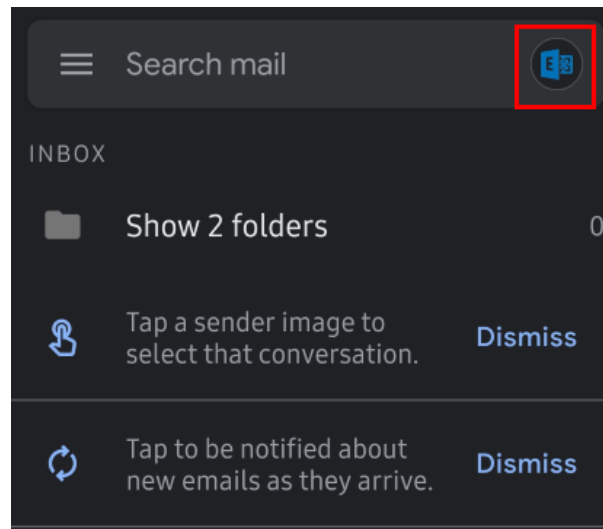
6. Enter your Email and password, for Server please enter “outlook.office365.com” and tap Next.
